<u>ADVANCED DIVISION:</u> Wrestlers who have varsity tournament experience or who have shown significant skill.

ADVANCED RULES: Neutral position takedowns, throws are allowed, **NO PICKUPS**. Control your opponent to the mat.

INTERMEDIATE DIVISION: This is for wrestlers who have some experience but who have not wrestled in a varsity tournament **OR** who have shown an above average technical ability/athleticism over fellow novice wrestlers.

NOVICE DIVISION: New wrestlers that have no prior live experience outside of practice and who do not meet the second criteria for intermediate above.

NOVICE/INTERMEDIATE RULES: Neutral position takedowns, **NO THROWS ALLOWED**, **NO PICKUPS**. Control your opponent to the mat.

<u>WHY?</u>: This is a great opportunity to expose newer wrestlers to live wrestling and to promote sound techniques and practices from the neutral position. We find that once a wrestler is comfortable with shooting and shot defense that the other parts become easier. This helps your team get a head start on the season!

HOW?: Each match will be one (1) running clock 2-minute round.

- A) Once a takedown happens, the wrestlers are brought back to their feet in the center of the mat. At the end of the match, whoever has the most takedowns wins.
- B) We will **pool the wrestlers by weight into groups of 5-6** wherever possible and each pool will compete on **one designated mat**.
- C) This is to promote shooting and shot defense. **RULES STATED ABOVE**(examples: double-leg to standing lift off the mat with a controlled descent is not permitted; a single leg where the attacker stands the foot up high and sweeps the leg will be permitted; any uncontrolled slams to the mat are **GROUNDS FOR DISQUALIFICATION**)

WEIGH INS / COST: Registration for wrestlers is \$15 and entry will be \$5 per adult at the door.

START TIME: *Intermediate and Advanced* will begin at 8am with split *Novice* sessions beginning around 1030a and 1230p. These times may vary depending on registration numbers. We will email coaches with pools and starting times the day before the tournament.

REGISTRATION: Coaches send in your rosters to symseaglewrestling@gmail.com no later than 12/12/24. Please include weight, age, and which division they will be competing in. We will pool girls together where we can. Please identify your female wrestlers you'd like pooled with other girls.
